- **The Special General Meeting to be held on 31 March has been postponed.** The business to be discussed at that meeting will now take place at the AGM on 16 June. If the current situation develops and persists placing the AGM in doubt then it will be moved to 1 December. In the meantime, the voting process currently underway will continue until 31 March. The ballot papers will be secured and the result not announced until the AGM.
